THE REV. GARRITT AND THE REV. SANETTE FLEMING COMING TO YORK

The Joint Board of First Moravian Church is delighted to welcome a clergy couple; the Rev. Garritt Fleming and the Rev. Sanette Fleming, who have accepted a call to serve Covenant Moravian and First Moravian Churches. The Flemings are currently serving as pastors of Schoeneck Moravian Church in Nazareth, Pa. Brother Garritt is from Easton, Pa. and was a member of Palmer Township Moravian Church. Sister Sanette is a native of Jamaica, and was a member of John Hus Moravian Church in Brooklyn, NY. The Flemings met when they were both students at Moravian Theological Seminary. They are in their thirties and have a three-year-old daughter, Esther Hadassah. Prior to serving Schoeneck Moravian both served as pastors for Moravian churches in Wisconsin. We have met with them on two different occasions and are excited to share this news because we have experienced them as deeply spiritual and well qualified pastors.

The Flemings need to finish their work at Schoeneck and will move to our parsonage in Dover on Tuesday, May 23. Their installation is scheduled for Sunday, June 18. They have visited York several times and have also stayed overnight in our parsonage to become familiar with the community. Since they will be serving both Covenant and First Churches there are many details yet to be worked out. Brother Garritt and Sister Sanette have requested to worship together as a family and both our boards and the boards at Covenant have agreed to keep them together on Sundays. Both First and Covenant may need to adjust our time for Sunday worship and we will share more information as it becomes available. During this time of transition please pray for Pastor Garritt and Pastor Sanette as they say farewell to friends and members at Schoeneck and prepare to move to York; and please pray also for the congregation at Schoeneck because they now must go through the same process of finding new pastoral leadership which we have just completed.
